

# NOS Orientation

**No Off Season** is proud to offer the finest varmint shooting experience available. Private fields, stable shooting platforms, your own personal shooting bench and steady rests make your shooting satisfying and productive. And, our deluxe field lunch will not leave you hungry! Snacks and cold drinks are available on your shooting platform, as well. (No alcohol is permitted during the shooting day.) A guide will make sure you have what you need to concentrate on the task at hand—keeping the barrel warm and the sagerats in danger!

The following is designed to help you get there and know what to expect when you arrive.

The address for **Rat Central** is 67808 South Harney Road, Burns, Oregon 97720. Travel time is approximately 20 minutes from Burns.

Directions to Rat Central are as follows: Go south on Hwy 78 from Burns, Oregon (go straight at the third traffic light if coming from the west) towards Winnemucca. Turn left 4/10ths of a mile past the 11 mile marker on Hutchensen Lane. Go to the end of Hutchensen Lane. Turn left (north) at the stop sign on South Harney Road. Go ¾ of a mile to the second place on the left. There is a white board fence at the entry to the driveway. The contact number for No Off Season is 541/589-0030. The number for the B&B is 541/589-4196.

Spring weather in Harney County is unpredictable so prepare for any weather. It may be shorts, shirt-sleeves and sunblock or it may be cool and windy so bring clothes appropriate for varying conditions including a warm hat and light gloves. A water- and windproof layer will make your shoot more comfortable when the breeze is blowing.

We have some good locations for both rimfire and centerfire shooting. Please let us know your preferences so we can put you in locations that best suit you. Please note that **Full Metal Jacket (FMJ) ammo including Ball and Green Tip ammunition is not allowed.** Please use only fragile, varmint type bullets (poly-tipped bullets are best) to reduce ricochets. For questions concerning your ammo, please contact **NOS**. **No Off Season** may be able to help you secure appropriate ammunition if you allow time. Rimfire hp or poly-tip ammo is recommended but rimfire solids are acceptable. Scope sights are highly recommended. Binoculars will help especially on early hunts.

Sagerat hunting is a great way to introduce kids to hunting in a controlled environment. Kids with Hunter Safety are welcome. If your child does not have Hunter Safety training, let us know. The parent is the best judge of the child's maturity and responsibility level but ensure an adult is able and willing to take the time to supervise them sufficiently for the safety of the child and those around them.

Concerning safety, your guide will act as Range Officer for your hunt. To ensure everyone is afforded a safe shooting environment, **No Off Season** has a zero tolerance policy concerning unsafe gun handling. Each shooter has an obligation and responsibility to adhere to safe gun handling and shooting practices as well as protecting people, property and domestic animals in the shooting area. If in doubt, hold your fire! There will be plenty of targets to come. If a shooter is deemed unsafe, **they will be asked to leave and will incur the full expense of the hunt.** A safe, enjoyable experience is everyone's responsibility. Hearing and eye protection will be available. If you don't have your own, ask your guide.
